Your 10-Minute Challenge today is to check your toilets for leaks: Place a drop of food coloring in the toilet tank. If the color shows up in the bowl within a few minutes, you may need a new flapper. Flush afterward to avoid staining the tank. 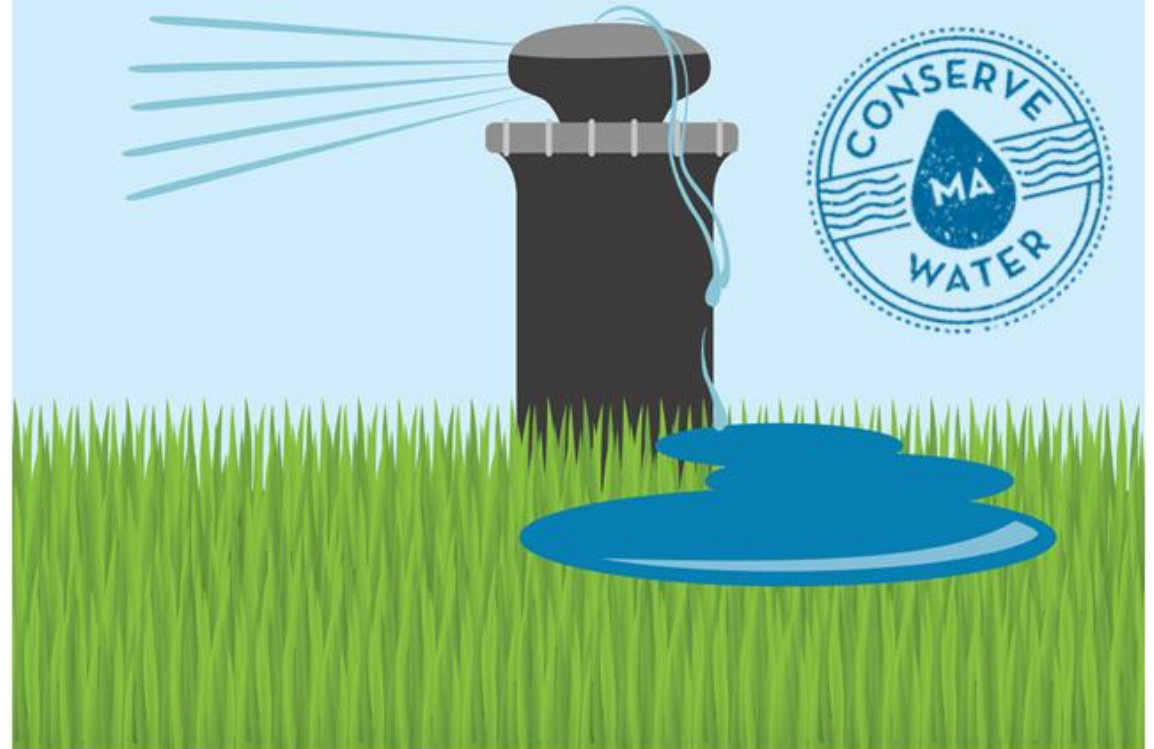
