

Entities Eligible to Use Contracts

- Executive Agencies (required)
- All Other State Agencies, including Quasi Public Agencies
- Public Colleges & Universities
- Eligible Non-profits
- Municipalities Cities and towns and others must follow M.G.L. c. 30B and may purchase from OSD Statewide Contracts per M.G.L. c. 7, §22A and M.G.L. c. 30B, §1(c).

How Do Buyers Benefit?

- ✓ Get the best value In FY21 alone the Commonwealth purchased more than \$2.0 billion in goods and services, resulting in significant buying power.
- Reduce administrative work OSD manages the procurement process: posting the RFR, coordinating the evaluation of responses, awarding vendors, negotiating the contract(s), and, ultimately, managing the contract through its expiration date.
- Experience excellent customer service Each OSD contract has a designated Sourcing Manager to assist buyers with questions and any issues regarding the contract. The <u>OSD Help Desk</u> also is available for assistance.







Executive Order 515 – Establishing an Environmental Purchasing Policy for the Commonwealth

"....help conserve natural resources, reduce waste, protect public health and the environment, and promote the use of clean technologies, recycled materials, and less toxic products."

Directs Departments to procure EPPs "whenever such products and services are **readily available**, **perform to satisfactory standards**, **represent best value to the Commonwealth**." **EPP Program Director**


- Co-Chairs the Toxics Reduction Task Force
- Develops new EPP specifications
- Designates minimum EPP requirements
- Promotes Products/Services to eligible users
- Writes Annual Progress Report
- Encourages national cooperation



EPPs: Products or services that have a lesser or reduced effect on human health and the environment when compared with competing products or services that serve the same purpose.



Post-Consumer Recycled Plastic (PCRP) Products on Statewide Contract



Contract Number	Contract Name	PCRP Product Groupings
<u>CLT08</u>	Clothing, Uniforms, Footwear, Accessories, Personal Care Products and Bedding	clothing (usually made with PCRC PET, known as fleece), to include sweatshirts, polos, uniforms, outerwear (RPET), winter gloves, hats
FAC85	Environmentally Preferable Cleaning Products, Programs, Equipment and Supplies	plastic bags; recycling/trash bins (office and public space); wheeled carts; mops; floor pads; floor mats
FAC86	Solid Waste and Recycling Services	plastic bags (including Pay As You Throw [PAYT] bags)
FAC98	Floorcoverings and Accessories, Floorcovering Installation, Maintenance and Repairs	carpet; carpet cushioning; hard surface flooring; carpet tile backing
FAC100	Building Maintenance Repair and Operations	drainage pipes; window boxes; copper-covered wire
<u>FAC101</u>	Facilities Maintenance, Repair and Operations Industrial Supplies	hard surface flooring; playground surfaces; playground and park furnishings amenities; outdoor shelter/shade structures; plastic lumber (fencing, deckin railings, partitions, landscape timbers); picnic tables; plastic bags; recycling, trash bins (office and public space); wheeled carts; storage boxes; drainage pipes
<u>FAC104</u>	Landscaping Products, Parks and Recreation Equipment and Related Products, Supplies and Services	playground equipment; playground surfaces; playground and park furnishings/amenities; sports and fitness equipment; outdoor shelter/shade structures; plastic lumber (fencing, decking, railings, partitions, landscape timbers); plicnic tables; grow bags; chairs; tables; swings
FAC105	Maintenance Repair and Operations Industrial and Building Retail Products	hard surface flooring; playground surfaces; playground and park furnishings amenities; outdoor shelter/shade structures; plastic lumber (fencing, deckin railings, partitions, landscape timbers); picnic tables; plastic bags; recycling, trash bins (office and public space); wheeled carts; storage boxes; drainage pipes; window boxes
FAC113	Recycling Containers, Compost Bins, and Rain Barrels	recycling/trash bins (office and public space); wheeled carts; home composting bins; buckets; rain barrels
FIRO4	Public Safety Equipment, Supplies, Services and Repairs	traffic cones and partitions
GRO34	Drinking Water- General and Emergency Services	plastic food service ware (cups, plates)
GRO35	Foodservice Supplies and Equipment, Institutional Commercial Grade Large and Small	plastic food service ware (cups, plates)
<u>HLS06</u>	Homeland Security, Public Safety, and Traffic Safety Supplies	traffic cones and partitions; fleece clothing; insulated gloves; hard hats
<u>ITC66</u>	Copiers, Printers, Scanners and Related Devices and Services	copiers and multifunctional devices (EPEAT certification required)
<u>ITC73</u>	IT Hardware and Services	computers and displays, copiers, and multifunctional devices (EPEAT or TCC certification required)
OFF38	Office, School and Library Furniture, Accessories and Installation	various furniture components
<u>OFF44</u>	Print, Copy and Mail Services, and Printed Promotional Products	various promotional materials: bags, pens, cups, bottles, straws, fans, drink glasses, cheering accessories, badge holders, tools, computer accessories, toys, battery rechargers and adaptors, travel mugs, key chains, apparel
OFF45	Art and Instructional School Supplies	various art supplies
OFF47	Office Supplies, Recycled Paper and Envelopes	binders; clipboards; plastic desktop accessories; plastic file folders; storage boxes; writing instruments
VEH96	Light, Medium, Heavy Duty OEM and Non-OEM Motorized Vehicle Parts, Refined Motor Oil, Lubricants	various vehicle parts

Market Development



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EO515 allows the program to set minimum requirements for EPPs outlined in the <u>Minimum Environmentally Preferable Products and Services Specifications Guide</u>.

Some examples:

- Copy paper: minimum 30% PCRC
- File folders: minimum 10% PCRC
- Napkins: minimum 30% PCRC
- Toilet paper: 20%
- Paper towels: 40%
- Plastic dimensional lumber: 90% PCRC






Market Development



- If there is a demand for products or services, OSD will work to make it available on Statewide Contract
- Specifications require market analysis: Different options
 - Require EPP
 - Allow conventional but must provide EPP option
 - o Desire EPP
- Vendors with one product:
 - Recommend subcontracting with primary vendors
 - FAC100 Building Maintenance Repair and Operations has rolling bid for open bid for Category 10 for EPP
