ZEM	Zero Emission Motorcycle



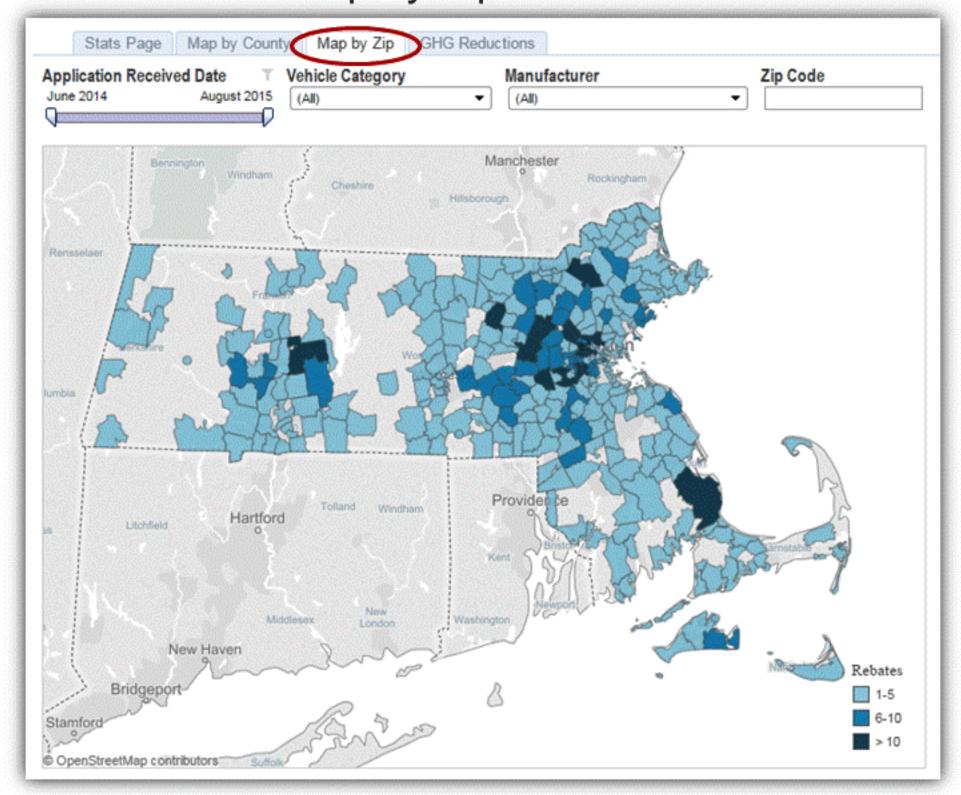
## Rebate Distribution Map by County



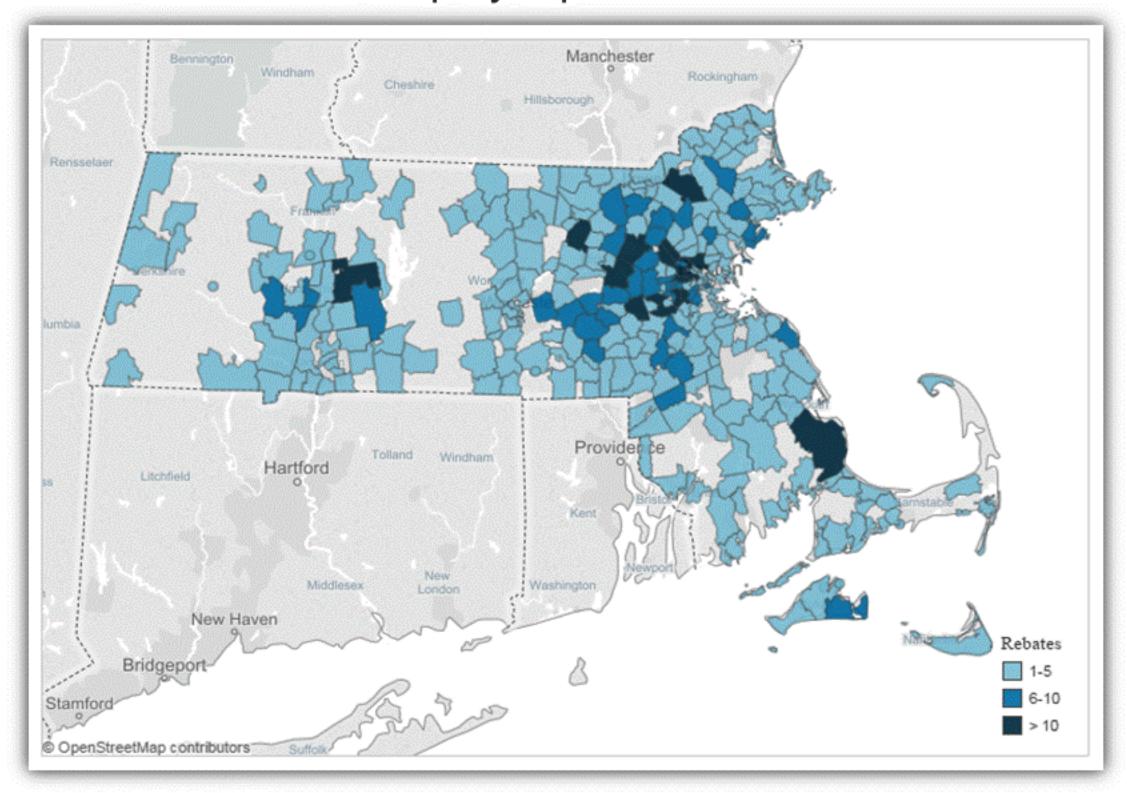
## Rebate Distribution Map by County



## Rebate Distribution Map by Zip

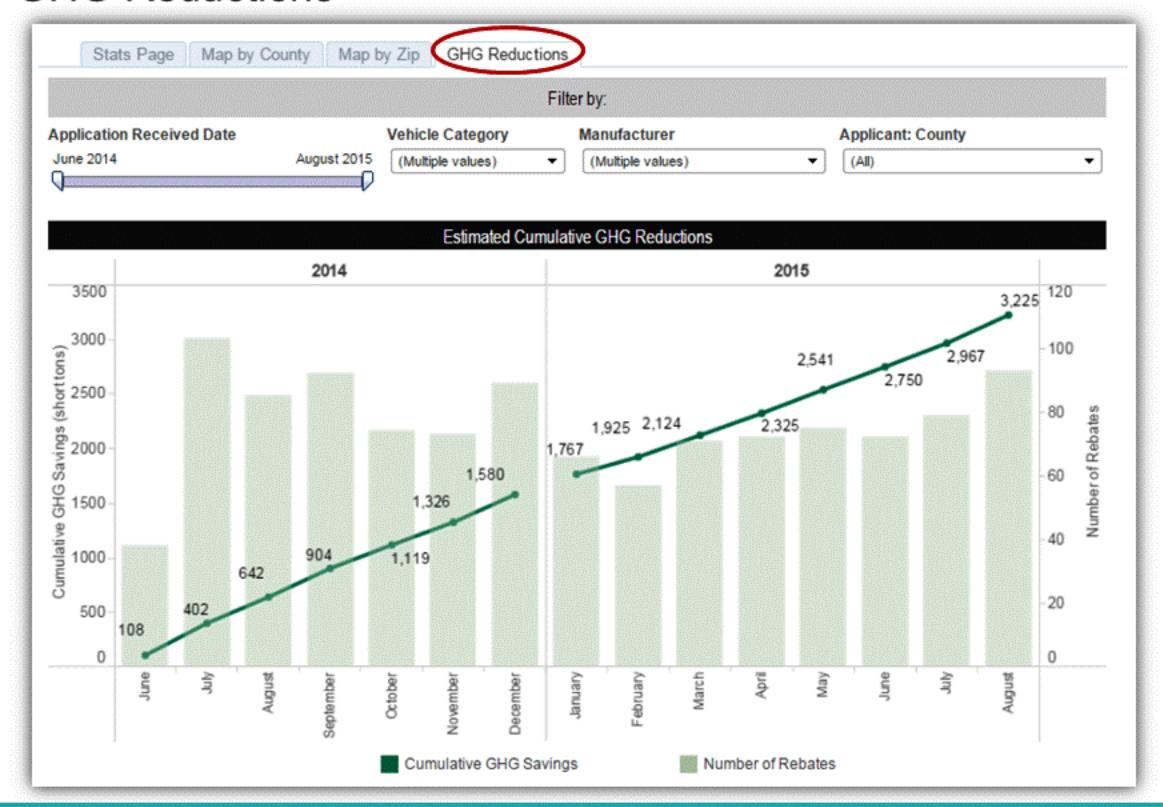

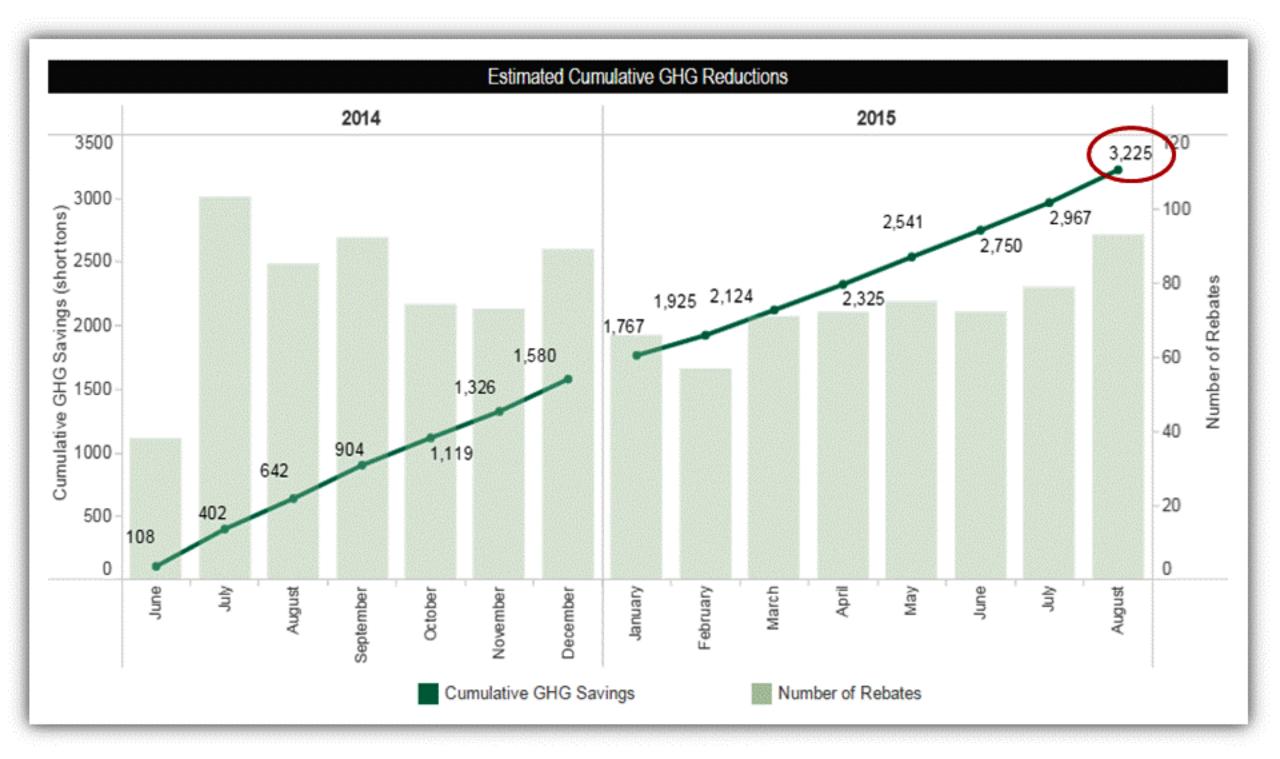

# Survey Analysis

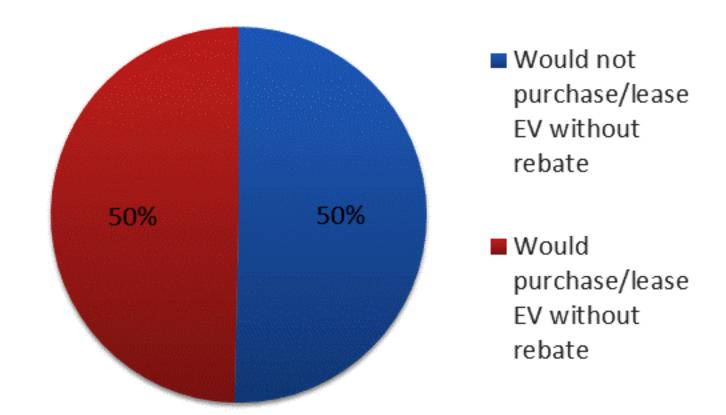
- 52% Response Rate
- Respondents are representative of MOR-EV population along the following parameters:
  - Vehicle Category, Vehicle Make and Vehicle Model
  - Ownership type (lease or purchase); lease terms
  - Geographic location (county and city)





## Effect of Rebate on Purchase/Lease Decision

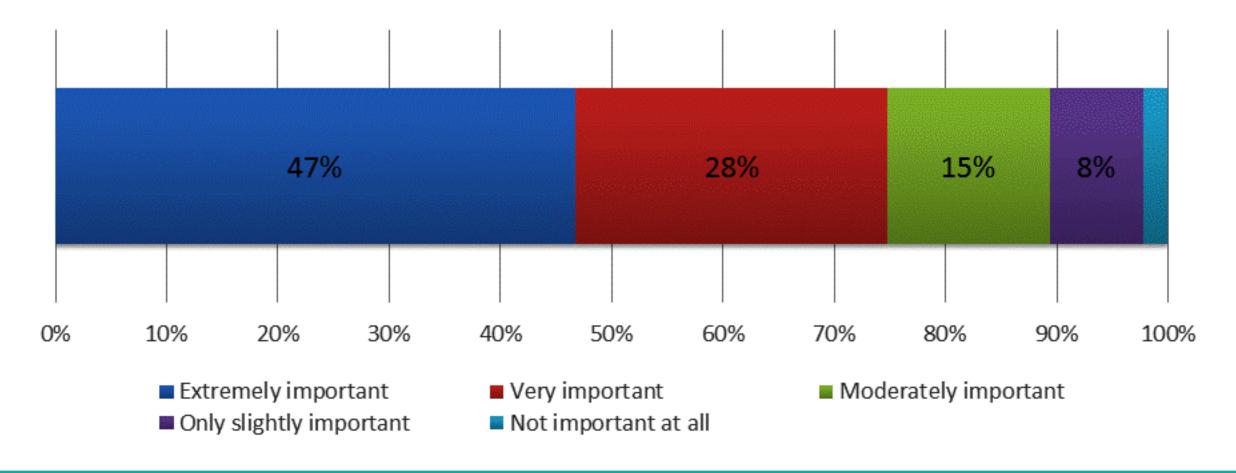
The number of adopters essentially doubled due to the importance of the rebate as a factor in the decision to adopt an EV.





# MOR-EV Impact

75% of adopters say the MOR-EV rebate was an "extremely" or "very" important factor in the decision making process to acquire an EV.

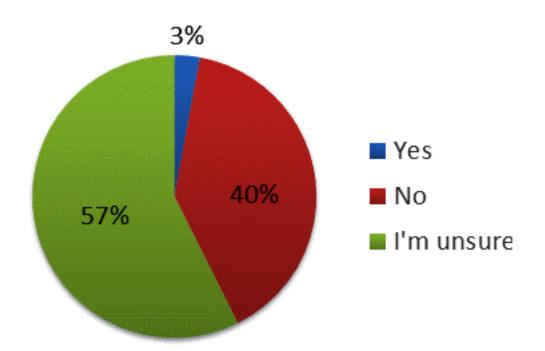




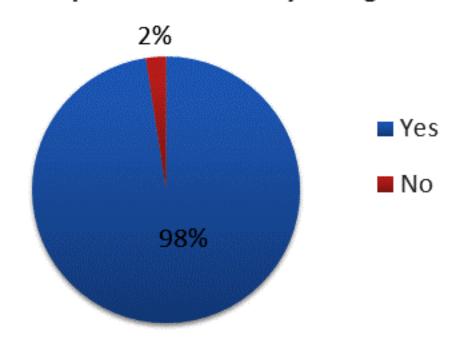


## Utility Time-of-Use Rate Availability

Does Your Electric Utility Offer Special Rates for Residential Electric Vehicle (EV) Charging?



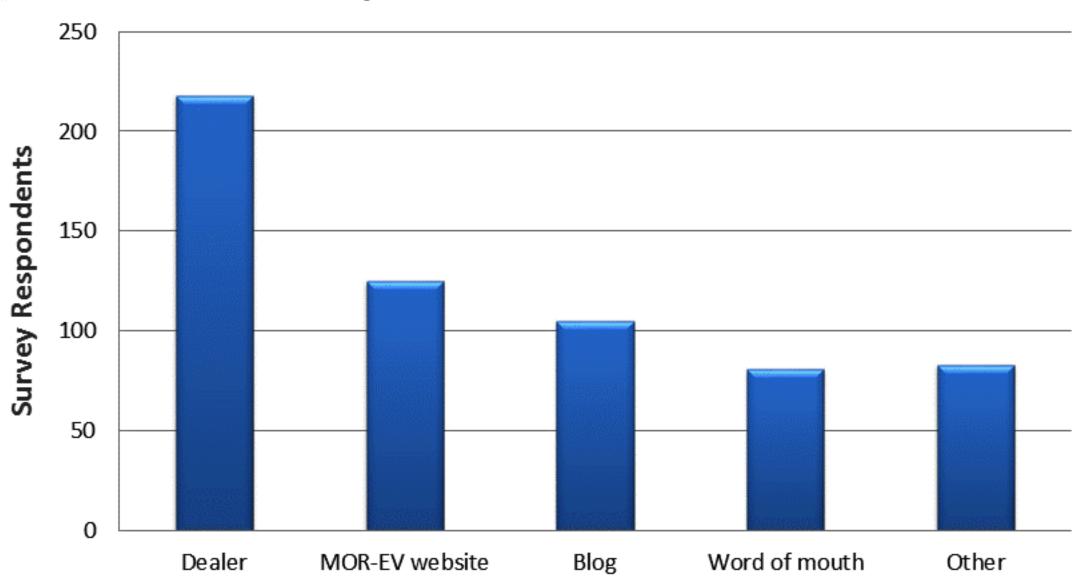

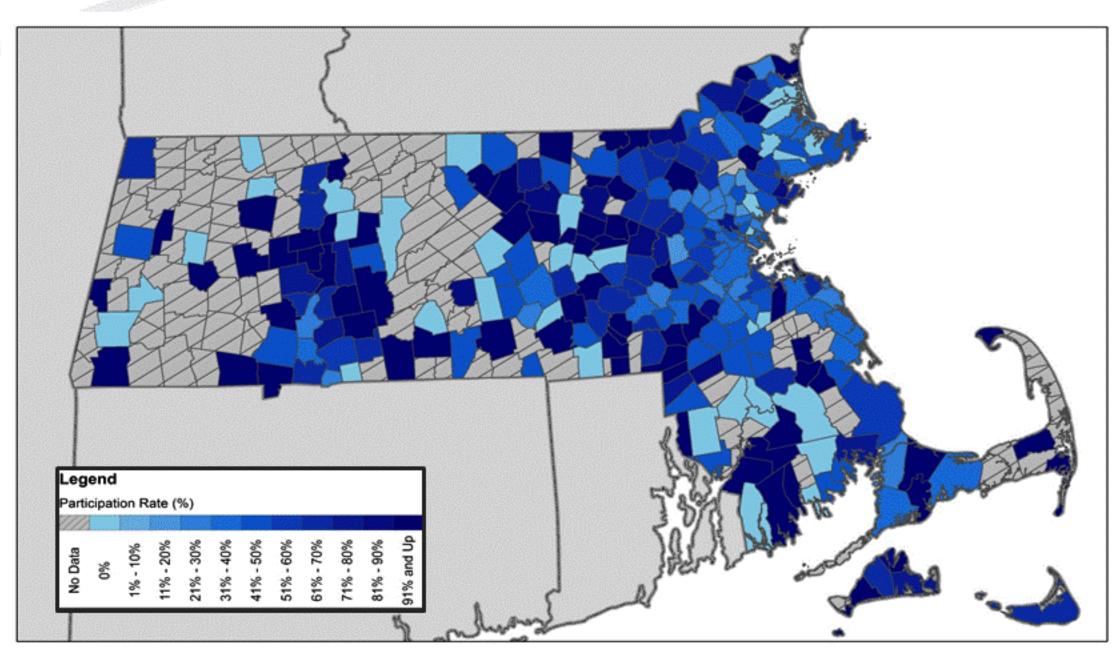

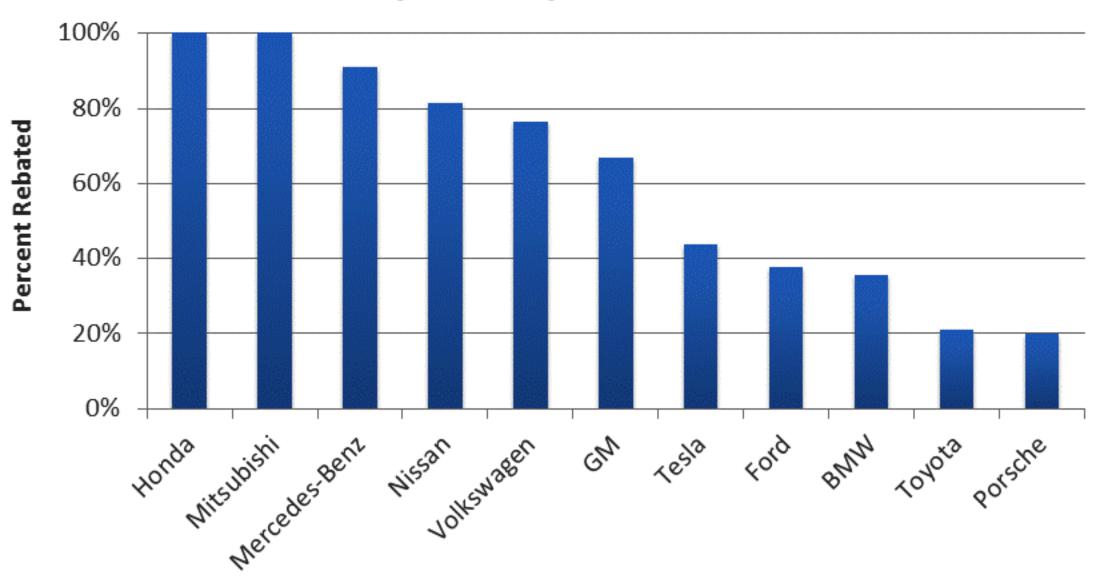
