## Refresher - Events Requiring Notification

- Combined Sewer Overflows (CSOs)
- Partially treated wastewater
- Blended wastewater
- Some types of Sanitary Sewer Overflows (SSOs)
  - any Sanitary Sewer Overflow that discharges through a wastewater outfall, either directly or indirectly, to a surface water of the Commonwealth;
  - any SSO that flows into a surface water of the Commonwealth and is the result of the sanitary sewer system surcharging under high flow conditions when peak flows cannot be conveyed to a POTW due to capacity constraints; and
  - any SSO that flows into a surface water of the Commonwealth and is the result of a failure of a
    wastewater pump station or associated force main designed to convey peak flows of one million
    gallons per day or greater




- Regulations promulgated on January 7, 2022
- Corrections to regulations promulgated on January 21, 2022
- Registration of 217 permittees to use the data system
- Brought the data system on-line July, 2022
- July 6 Permittees began issuing public advisory notification and reporting into the data system



## Outreach and Training



Follow-up efforts increased Data System registration from 64% in July to 87% today for SSO permittees




### CSO Public Notification Plans

- Required for all CSO permittees and requires MassDEP approval
  - Preliminary plans were due May 1, 2022;
  - Final plans are due January 12, 2023
  - Final plans will be noticed in Environmental Monitor
- Must identify method for determining discharges and estimating volume of discharges at each outfall
- Must include information about permittee's website, signage, measures to communicate to EJ populations
- 100% Compliance All CSO Permittees submitted Preliminary CSO Plans on time


# SSO Public Notification Plan

- Required for all non-CSO permittees
- Were due July 6, 2022
- Presumptive approval after 180 days
- MassDEP provided template for plan development
- Must describe how permittee will meet notification requirements, including information about permittee's website, signage, measures to communicate to EJ populations

# Follow-up efforts increased SSO plan compliance from 81% in July to 93% today




#### The Data System collects and organizes data for reporting and analysis
