Effective Reporting Year 2022 New Certain PFAS NOL Category for Reports Due July 1, 2023

- •For the 2022 Reporting Year, the Certain PFAS NOL (Not Otherwise Listed) category has been added under TURA.
- •Heather Tenney will be discussing how the new PFAS NOL category is defined in the next presentation.

New Certain PFAS NOL Category

•Reporting of this Certain PFAS NOL category is at typical TURA reportable thresholds of 25,000 pounds manufactured or processed and 10,000 pounds otherwise used annually.

- •Pages 2-9 of Changes for TURA Reporting Year 2022
- •Includes the list of PFAS that are reported as part of the TURA Certain PFAS NOL category (**DEP Category #1300**).

Guidance for New Certain PFAS NOL Category

- •Guidance for reporting the Certain PFAS NOL Category begins on page 80 of the TURA Reporting Instructions Appendices
- •Also found in <u>additional sheet</u> of TURA Chemical List which includes a non-exhaustive list of chemicals included in the PFAS NOL category that are TURA reportable

New TRI PFAS Chemicals Reportable Under TURA as Part of Certain PFAS NOL Category

- •The first **eight** chemicals highlighted in gray toward the end of the Certain PFAS NOL Category list in guidance are PFAS chemicals that TRI has listed for reporting years 2021 and 2022.
- •These chemicals have been adopted by the TURA Administrative Council, and will be reportable <u>individually</u> under TURA effective <u>reporting year 2023</u>, for reports due July 1, 2024.
- •However, this reporting year 2022, these eight chemicals are to be reported under TURA as part of the Certain PFAS NOL category.

- •The last **nine** chemicals highlighted in gray toward the end of the Certain PFAS NOL Category list in the guidance are PFAS chemicals that TRI has listed for reporting year 2023.
- •TURA shall adopt these changes pending an Administrative Council vote, but until they are adopted by the Council, these nine chemicals <u>are to be reported</u> <u>under TURA as part of the Certain PFAS NOL category</u>.

Rules for Reporting Specifically Listed Chemicals vs. Chemical Categories Matrix – Row 12

- •For example, Octafluoropropane (CAS# 76-19-7)
- •This chemical is reportable under **both** the C1-C4 TURA NOL Category (**1047**) and the Certain PFAS NOL Category (**1300**).
- You would report <u>both chemical categories</u> and pay <u>one</u> fee.
