

Primary Care Sub-Capitation Provider Type and Specialty Logic- Effective 1/1/2024

In addition to meeting other criteria from the primary care sub-capitation claims logic, the servicing or attending provider must have at least one specialty from the Included Provider Specialties list below and none from the Excluded Provider Specialties list below. There are several provider specialties that are not on either list. These unlisted specialties have no impact on whether a claim is covered by primary care sub-capitation.

At least one of the following included provider specialties:

- Adolescent Medicine
- Family Medicine
- General Medicine
- Geriatric Medicine
- Internal Medicine
- Nurse Practitioner
- Pediatric Medicine
- Physician Assistant
- Preventive Medicine
- Osteopathic Medicine

Must not have one of the following excluded provider specialties:

- Anesthesiology
- Critical Care
- Dermatology
- Gastroenterology
- Hematology
- Nephrology
- Neurology
- Nuclear Medicine
- Oncology
- Ophthalmology
