Measures to protect life, public health, and safety are generally the responsibility of SLTT governments. For example, local governments are legally responsible for emergency feeding programs. Private Non-Profits must enter into agreements with local governments and the municipality is responsible for submitting the FEMA Public Assistance application. PPEs are only eligible for facilities/individuals performing eligible COVID-19
