Course Name: Procurement under FEMA Awards: Requirements for Recipients and Sub-Recipients When

Procuring Services, Equipment, and Supplies with Funding under FEMA Grant Programs

Course Goal: Reduce non-Federal entity violations of the Federal procurement regulations by training

participants on the requirements set forth at 2 C.F.R. §§ 200.317 through 200.326 (the

"Uniform Rules").

Course Description: This half-day training focuses on the requirements set forth in the Uniform Rules so that

participants can identify and avoid potential violations of the Federal procurement requirements. Topics include: overview and use of contracts; procurement by tribal, state, and local governments, hospitals, institutions of higher education, and other nonprofit organizations; competition; methods of procurement; cost or price analysis; contractor

bonding requirements; and contract provisions.

Target Audience: Federal, State, local government officials who are involved in federal grant applications and

federal grant project management.

Prerequisites: None.
