(b) Less Than a Full Jury. If after jeopardy attaches there is at any time during the progress of a trial less than a full jury remaining, the trial judge may allow the a-defendant to may waive his the right to be tried by a full jury, after determining at a colloquy that such waiver is knowing and voluntary. The defendant shall and request trial by the remaining jurors by signing a written waiver, which shall be filed with the court. If there is more than one defendant, each must waive the right to be tried by a full juryall must sign and file a waiver unless the court judge exercises in its discretion to severs the cases.
