Rule 65.1: Security: Proceedings against sureties security provider

Whenever these rules require or permit the giving of security by a party, and security is given in the form of a bond or stipulation or other undertaking with one or more suretiessecurity providers, each surety provider submits himself to the jurisdiction of the court and irrevocably appoints the clerk of the court as his their agent upon whom any papers affecting his the liability on the bond or undertaking security may be served. His The security provider's liability may be enforced on motion without the necessity of an independent action. The motion and such notice of the motion as the court prescribes may be served on the clerk of the court, who shall forthwith mail send copies to the sureties if their addresses are each security provider whose address is known.
