| <b>Proposed Action</b>  | Non-Major Comprehensive Plan Approval   |
| Purpose:                | Canal Generating, LLC submitted a Non-Major Comprehensive Air Quality<br>Plan Application for the alteration of an existing electric generating facility.<br>The Applicant is proposing to lower the allowable sulfur content in the oil<br>fired in boiler Unit 1 to 0.3 percent by weight (% wt) following the depletion of<br>the current inventory. The proposed oil sulfur limit of 0.3 % wt is below the<br>current applicable regulatory limit of 0.5 % wt in the MassDEP regulations.<br>The project will not include installation of any new equipment, removal of any<br>existing approved equipment, modifications to any approved pollution control<br>equipment. The proposed reduction in oil sulfur content will result in a<br>reduction in potential sulfur dioxide emissions from Unit 1. |
