Proposed Action	Approve the proposed 2020 Supplemental Application
Purpose:	To amend the previously issued 2016 Final Air Quality Plan Approval CE-15-016, Transmittal No.: X265409, to allow for the combustion of ultra-low sulfur kerosene as back-up fuel oil, in addition to the already approved ultra low sulfur distillate fuel oil, and to establish new opacity limits while burning fuel oil.

The proposed 2020 Amended Plan Approval superseded the 2016 Final Approval does not change any other emission limits or operating requirements included in the original underlying 2016 Final Approval. Key changes to opacity and back-up fuel type are highlighted in the proposed 2020 Amended Plan Approval to reflect this narrow focus, and although this proposed 2020 Amended Plan Approval letter shall supersede, in its entirety, the Final Approval letter issued on December 19, 2016, and the 2020 Amended Plan Approval fully incorporates all of the other requirements set forth in the 2016 Final approval. Because none of the conditions and requirements in the 2016 MassDEP will change, MassDEP will only accept during the public comment period any comments on the proposed 2020 Amended Plan Approval that change the opacity limit and addition of ULSK as back-up fuel and not on any of the other conditions originally approved in the 2016 Final Approval and that are now included in this proposed 2020 Amended Plan Approval. MassDEP will consider the public comments received before it decides to issue a Final 2020 Amended Plan Approval.
