In lieu of enforcement of the Receiver's lien through an auction sale of the Property, the lien holder, Wells Fargo Bank, N.A, as Trustee for ABFC 2006-OPT2 Trust, ABFC Asset-Backed Certificates, Series 2006-OPT3, will satisfy and redeem the Receiver's lien by paying it off in full by the end of business on May 25, 2018;
- The Receiver, therefore, shall be discharged of its duties and this receivership terminated upon receipt of the check from Wells Fargo Bank, N.A, as Trustee for ABFC 2006-OPT2 Trust, ABFC Asset-Backed Certificates, Series 2006-OPT3 satisfying the lien on May 25, 2018;
- 5. The Petitioner, the Attorney General, will thereafter file to dismiss this action with prejudice within one week.
