Clipper Ventures, Inc. dba The Squealing Pig (the "Licensee") holds an all alcohol license issued pursuant to Massachusetts General Laws c.138, §12. The Alcoholic Beverages Control Commission (the "Commission") held a hearing on Tuesday, August 30, 2011, regarding an alleged violation of M.G.L. c. 138, §34. Prior to the commencement of the hearing, the licensee stipulated to the violation alleged in Investigator Jamie Binienda's Compliance Check Field Report.

2. Compliance Check Field Report of Investigator Jamie Binienda.

FACTS


1. On, June 25, 2011 at approximately 7:22 p.m., Commission Investigators investigated the business operation Clipper Ventures, Inc. dba The Squealing Pig.
2. An underage operative, working with the investigators, possessed a Blue Moon draft. The underage operative was not asked for identification.
3. Administrative review of the file indicates that this is the first violation for this licensee in eleven (11) years of existence.

CONCLUSION

Based on the evidence, the Commission finds the licensee violated Massachusetts General Laws c. 138, §34. Therefore, the Commission issues a **WARNING**.


