## DECISION

JULESAN, INC. DBA TWIST'D SISTERS 293 COMMERCIAL STREET PROVINCETOWN, MA 02657

Julesan, Inc. dba Twist'd Sisters (the "Licensee") holds an all alcohol license issued pursuant to Massachusetts General Laws chapter 138, §12. The Alcoholic Beverages Control Commission ("the Commission") held a hearing on Tuesday, October 18, 2011, regarding an alleged violation of M.G.L. c. 138, §34. Prior to the commencement of the hearing, the licensee stipulated to the violation alleged in Investigator Jamie Binienda's Compliance Check Field Report.

## **FACTS**

- 1. On, June 25, 2011 at approximately 7:40 p.m., Commission Investigators investigated the business operation Julesan, Inc. dba Twist'd Sisters.
- 2. An underage operative, working with the investigators, purchased a can of Bud Light for four dollars and twenty-five cents (\$4.25). The underage operative was not asked for identification.

## CONCLUSION

Based on the evidence, the Commission finds the licensee violated Massachusetts General Laws c. 138, §34. The Commission suspends the license for three (3) days of which (3) days will be held in abeyance for a period of two (2) years provided no further violations of Chapter 138 or Commission Regulations occur.
