DECISION

NEXTEP HOSPITALITY INC. D/B/A GOVERNOR BRADFORD RESTAURANT

Nextep Hospitality Inc. d/b/a Governor Bradford Restaurant ("Licensee") holds an alcohol license issued pursuant to M.G.L. c. 138, § 12. The Alcoholic Beverages Control Commission ("ABCC" or "Commission") held a remote hearing via Microsoft Teams on Tuesday, January 9, 2024, regarding an alleged violation of 204 CMR 2.05 (2) Permitting an illegality on the licensed premises, to wit: M.G.L. Ch. 138, § 34 Sale or Delivery of an alcoholic beverage to a person under twenty-one years of age. Prior to the commencement of the hearing the Licensee stipulated to the facts alleged in Investigators Velez and Binienda's Minimum Purchase Age Compliance Check Field Report.

FINDINGS OF FACT

- 1. On Thursday, June 22, 2023, at approximately 5:22 p.m., Investigators Velez and Binienda ("Investigators") conducted a compliance check at Nextep Hospitality Inc. d/b/a Governor Bradford Restaurant.
- 2. An underage operative, working under the supervision of Investigators, was served an alcoholic beverage, one White Claw Black Cherry Hard Seltzer. The underage operative was not asked for identification.

3. The Licensee has held a license under M.G.L. c. 138, § 12 since 2022 with no prior violations.

CONCLUSION

Based on the evidence, the Commission finds the Licensee violated 204 CMR 2.05 (2) Permitting an illegality on the licensed premises, to wit: M.G.L. Ch. 138, § 34 Sale or Delivery of an alcoholic beverage to a person under twenty-one years of age. Therefore, the Commission issues a **WARNING.**
