## **DECISION**

Saki, LLC dba John Dough's 256-58 Commercial Street Provincetown, MA 02657 License #: 100400026 Heard: August 30, 2011

Saki, LLC dba John Dough's (the "Licensee") holds an all alcohol license issued pursuant to Massachusetts General Laws c.138, §12. The Alcoholic Beverages Control Commission (the "Commission") held a hearing on Tuesday, August 30, 2011, regarding an alleged violation of M.G.L. c. 138, §34. Prior to the commencement of the hearing, the licensee stipulated to the violation alleged in Investigator Jamie Binienda's Compliance Check Field Report.

The following documents are in evidence:

- 1. Licensee's Stipulation of Facts; and
- 2. Compliance Check Field Report of Investigator Jamie Binienda.

## **FACTS**

- 1. On, June 23, 2011 at approximately 7:52 p.m., Commission Investigators investigated the business operation Saki, LLC dba John Dough's.
- 2. An underage operative, working with the investigators, purchased a Sam Adams draft for six dollars (\$6.00). The underage operative was not asked for identification.
- 3. Administrative review of the file indicates that this is the first violation for this licensee in three (3) years of existence.

## CONCLUSION

Based on the evidence, the Commission finds the licensee violated Massachusetts General Laws c. 138, §34. Therefore, the Commission suspends the license for three (3) days of which three (3) days will be held in abeyance for a period of two (2) years provided no further violations of Chapter 138 or Commission regulations occur.
