DECISION

SUMMER COASTLINE, INC. DBA THE PIED PIPER BAR 193A COMMERCIAL ST. PROVINCETOWN, MA 02657 LICENSE#: 100400048

Summer Coastline, Inc. dba The Pied Piper Bar (the "Licensee") holds an alcohol license issued pursuant to M.G.L. c. 138, §12. The Alcoholic Beverages Control Commission (the "Commission") held a hearing on Tuesday, September 9, 2014, regarding an alleged violation of 204 CMR 2.05 (2) - Permitting an illegality on the licensed premises, to wit: c. 138, §34 – Sale or delivery of an alcoholic beverage to a person under twenty-one (21) years of age. Prior to the commencement of the hearing, the licensee stipulated to the violation alleged in Investigator Velez's Report.

The following documents are in evidence:

- 1. Licensee's Stipulation of Facts;
- 2. Investigator Velez's Compliance Check Field Report dated June 19, 2013.

There is one (1) audio recording of this hearing.

FACTS

- 1. On Wednesday, June 19, 2013, at approximately 7:24 p.m., Investigators Binienda and Velez conducted an investigation of the business operation of Summer Coastline, Inc. dba The Pied Piper Bar.
- 2. An underage operative, working with investigators, purchased an alcoholic beverage, a bottle of Budweiser Light beer for four dollars and seventy-five cents (\$4.75). The underage operative was not asked for identification.

CONCLUSION

Based on the evidence, the Commission finds the licensee violated 204 CMR 2.05 (2) - Permitting an illegality on the licensed premises, to wit: c. 138, §34 - Sale or delivery of an alcoholic beverage to a person under twenty-one (21) years of age. As the licensee has not had a violation in more twenty (20) years, therefore the Commission issues a **WARNING**.
