RE: Psychologist Manual 2020 (Revised Service Codes and Descriptions)

This letter transmits revisions to the service codes and descriptions listed in Subchapter 6 of the Psychologist Manual. Subchapter 6 has been updated to add two codes for psychological testing administration and scoring by technicians. In addition, Subchapter 6 has been updated to include the range of hours for psychological testing service codes for independent psychologists enrolled as MassHealth providers. These codes and descriptions are effective for dates of service on or after January 1, 2020.

Psychological Testing Evaluation Services by Professional

- Psychological testing evaluation services by physician or other qualified health care professional, including integration of patient data, interpretation of standardized test results and clinical data, clinical decision making, treatment planning and report and interactive feedback to the patient, family member(s) or caregiver(s), when performed; first hour (not to exceed one unit).
- Each additional hour. (List separately in addition to code for primary procedure.) (Add-on code to 96130 not to exceed seven one-hour units).

Neuropsychological Testing Evaluation Services by Professional

- Neuropsychological testing evaluation services by physician or other qualified health care professional, including integration of patient data, interpretation of standardized test results and clinical data, clinical decision making, treatment planning and report and interactive feedback to the patient, family member(s) or caregiver(s), when performed; first hour (not to exceed one one-hour unit).
- Each additional hour. (List separately in addition to code for primary procedures.) (Add-on code to 96132 not to exceed seven one-hour units.)

Test Administration and Scoring by Professional

- Psychological or neuropsychological test administration and scoring by physician or other qualified health care professional, two or more tests, any method; first 30 minutes (not to exceed one thirty-minute unit).
- Each additional 30 minutes. (List separately in addition to code for primary procedure.) (Addon code to 96136 not to exceed eleven thirty-minute units.)

Test Administration and Scoring by Technician

- Psychological or neuropsychological test administration and scoring by technician, two or more tests, any method; first thirty minutes (not to exceed one thirty-minute unit).
- Each additional 30 minutes (List separately in addition to code for primary procedure). (Add-on code to 96138 not to exceed eleven thirty minute units).
