**Board Business**

- **Roll Call for Attendance:** Mr. Bialas called the roll of Board members, and all were in attendance.

At 9:08 a.m., a motion was made by Dr. Brown, seconded by Dr. Anderson, to (1) exit the public meeting; (2) enter into executive session under G.L. c. 30A, § 21(a)(1), individual character rather than competence, and under G.L. c. 30A, § 21(a)(7) to comply with G.L. c. 4, § 7, ¶ 26(c) and G.L. c. 214, § 1B – adhering to the public records law and to preserve the confidentiality of medical record information, to interview an applicant for licensure, interview an applicant for reinstatement, and review examination accommodation requests; then (3) enter into investigative conference under G.L. c. 112, § 65C to review cases; and (4) at the conclusion of the investigative conference, not return to the public meeting. The motion passed unanimously by a roll call vote.
