My Generation Energy Comments on Emergency Regulations Under 225 CMR 14.00

My Generation Energy appreciates the DOER's work on this important matter with regards to the Solar Renewable Carve Out program. These emergency regulations will, and have, advanced the public interest by:

- avoiding a significant market disruption;
- avoiding substantial job losses in the state;
- protecting homeowners and small businesses;
- alleviating costly, dangerous peak demand conditions on the electric grid; and by
