Notice is hereby given that the Department of Environmental Protection (MassDEP), under its authority pursuant to M.G.L. c. 21, § 27A, is proposing amendments to its regulations at 310 CMR 44.00: *DEP Selection, Approval and Regulation of Water Pollution Abatement Projects Receiving Financial Assistance from the State Revolving Fund*. The SRF program is a federal-state partnership that provides state-subsidized, below-market interest rate loans to local governments and Public Water Suppliers to reduce the cost of local debt to construct or rehabilitate water infrastructure.
