

**Public Hearing Notice**  
**2026 Clean Water & Drinking Water SRF Draft Intended Use Plans**

The Massachusetts Department of Environmental Protection (MassDEP), Division of Water Investment, has released the calendar year 2026 Draft Intended Use Plans (IUPs) for the Clean Water State Revolving Fund (CWSRF) and the Drinking Water State Revolving Fund (DWSRF). The purpose of the CWSRF is to assist communities in implementing the requirements of the Federal and State Clean Water Act. The purpose of the DWSRF program is to assist Public Water Suppliers to implement the requirements of the Federal Safe Drinking Water Act.

The Draft IUPs list projects by priority ranking that MassDEP will recommend being financed through the Massachusetts Clean Water Trust in calendar year 2026. The Draft IUPs list those projects determined to be the most significant in terms of public health and environmental protection.
