Notice is hereby given of the Chapter 91 Application by The Rowes Wharf Condominium Association and the City of Boston to install a 50-foot long (620 square foot) floating dock at the seaward end of the existing docking facility located within flowed tidelands of Boston Harbor at 60 Rowes Wharf, Boston, Suffolk County. The project has been preliminarily determined to be a Water-Dependent Use. The proposed docking facility is proposed in a location seaward of a State Harbor Line, and is requesting authorization as allowed pursuant to Chapter 204 of the Legislative Acts of 2010.

The Department will consider all applicable written comments on this application received by April 17, 2026 (public comment deadline). Failure of any aggrieved person or group of ten (10) citizens or more to submit written comments to the Department by the public comment deadline will result in the waiver of any right to an adjudicatory hearing in accordance with 310 CMR 9.13(4)(c). The group of citizens must include at least five (5) citizens who are residents of the municipality in which the project is located.
