Public Notice is hereby given of the Chapter 91 license application by the Procopio Companies for redevelopment of a surface parking lot into a shared-use pathway and parking lot within Filled Private Tidelands of the Weir River at 0 George Washington Boulevard (Property ID 37-002), Hull, Plymouth County. The project has been determined to be Nonwater-Dependent. **This second notice and comment period for the project are to address a notification deficiency; there has been no change to the project from the initial notice.**

The Public Hearing will be held remotely on December 4, 2025 at 11:00am through Zoom. It is recommended that you test connectivity/functionality in advance of the meeting.

The Department will conduct this Public Hearing in order to receive information to be used in its decision on whether to grant a License pursuant to M.G.L. Chapter 91.

The Department will consider all written comments on this Chapter 91 Application received by December 29, 2025 (Public Comment Deadline). Failure of any aggrieved person or group of ten (10) citizens or more to submit written comments to the Department by the Public Comments Deadline will result in the waiver of any right to an adjudicatory hearing in accordance with 310 CMR 9.13(4)(c). The group of citizens must include at least five (5) citizens who are residents of the municipality in which the proposed project is located.
