Notice is hereby given of the Chapter 91 Application by Clippership Wharf Multifamily Holdings LLC to amend Chapter 91 License No. 14043 for after-the-fact authorization of modifications to the previously authorized living shoreline, seawall, revetment and associated dredging area; modifications to previously authorized restaurant and fitness facility spaces, pier, gangway, and docking facility; and to authorize a retail center in-lieu of a previously proposed “Canoe and Kayak Center” for the extended license term of the original license, located within Filled and Flowed Tidelands of Boston Harbor at 26-65 Lewis St, Boston, Suffolk County. The project has been preliminarily determined to be a Nonwater-Dependent Use.

**The Public Hearing will be held remotely on January 8, 2026 at 2:00pm via Zoom.** Prior to the meeting, please download and sign up for an account for this free software at <https://zoom.us> on a phone, tablet, desktop or laptop computer. It is recommended that connectivity/functionality be tested in advance of the meeting.

The Department will conduct this hearing in order to receive information to be used in its decision on whether to grant a License pursuant to M.G.L. Chapter 91.

**The Department will consider all applicable written comments on this application received by January 28, 2026 (public comment deadline).** Failure of any aggrieved person or group of ten (10) citizens or more to submit written comments to the Department by the public comment deadline will result in the waiver of any right to an adjudicatory hearing in accordance with 310 CMR 9.13(4)(c). The group of citizens must include at least five (5) citizens who are residents of the municipality in which the project is located.
