Public Notice is hereby given of the Chapter 91 License Application by the Town of Wilmington for authorization to replace an existing culvert, including improvement dredging, within waters of Martins Brook at Salem Street Right-of-Way, 0 Salem Street (Map 101 Lot 3), 0 Salem Street (Map 102, Lot 3), 0 Salem Street (Map 102 Lot 4), 500 Salem Street (Map 102 Lot 1A) in the Town of Wilmington, Middlesex County. The proposed project has preliminarily been determined to be a Water-Dependent Use Project.

The Department will consider all written comments on this Chapter 91 Application received by April 20, 2026 (Public Comment Deadline). Failure of any aggrieved person or group of ten (10) citizens or more to submit written comments to the Department by the public comment deadline will result in the waiver of any right to an adjudicatory hearing in accordance with 310 CMR 9.13(4)(c). The group of citizens must include at least five (5) citizens who are residents of the municipality in which the proposed project is located. A public hearing may be held upon request by the Municipal Official.
