Public notice is hereby given of the Chapter 91 Permit application by NSTAR Gas Company d/b/a, Eversource Energy for authorization to dredge and backfill an approximately 66,200-square foot area as part of a remediation project, within waters of Beaver Dam Brook, Framingham, Middlesex County. The proposed project has preliminarily been determined to be a water-dependent use.

The Department will consider all applicable written comments on this application received by September 28, 2026. Failure of any aggrieved person or group of ten (10) citizens or more to submit written comments to the Waterways Regulation Program by the public comment deadline will result in the waiver of any right to an adjudicatory hearing in accordance with 310 CMR 9.13(4)(c). The group of citizens must include at least five (5) citizens who are residents of the municipality in which the proposed project is located. A public hearing may be held upon request by the Municipal Official.
