Public notice is hereby given of the Chapter 91 License application by the Salem Harbor Port Authority for construction and maintenance of a new water transportation terminal building and accessory structures in the Salem Designated Port Area and Municipal Harbor Planning Area within Filled Tidelands of Salem Harbor in the City of Salem, Essex County. The proposed project has preliminarily been determined to be a Water-Dependent Industrial Use and Accessory Use.

The Department will consider all written comments on this application received by October 23, 2026 (Public Comments Deadline). Failure of any aggrieved person or group of ten (10) citizens or more to submit written comments to the Waterways Regulation Program by the Public Comments Deadline will result in the waiver of any right to an adjudicatory hearing in accordance with 310 CMR 9.13(4)(c). The group of citizens must include at least five (5) citizens who are residents of the municipality in which the proposed project is located. A public hearing may be held at the request of the Municipal Official.
