Public notice is hereby given of the Chapter 91 License Application by Enterprise Rent-A-Car Company of Boston, LLC to amend Chapter 91 License No. WW14-0000038 (15409) for the placement of three removable structures (2 carports and 1 shed) within the existing paved parking lot located in the Chelsea Creek DPA within Filled Tidelands of Chelsea Creek at 239 Marginal Street, Chelsea, Suffolk County. This project is within the City of Chelsea Approved Municipal Harbor Planning Area. The project has been preliminarily determined to be a Nonwater-Dependent Use.

The public hearing for this Application will be conducted remotely via Zoom on September 3, 2026 at 2:00pm. It is recommended that you test connectivity/ functionality in advance of the meeting.

Advance registration is required to participate in the public hearing. Please register using the registration link above. The Department will conduct this public hearing in order to receive information to be used in its decision on whether to grant a License pursuant to M.G.L. Chapter 91.

The Department will consider all written comments on this application received by September 28, 2026 (public comment deadline). Failure of any aggrieved person or group of ten (10) citizens or more to submit written comments to the Department by the public comment deadline will result in the waiver of any right to an adjudicatory hearing in accordance with 310 CMR 9.13(4)(c). The group of citizens must include at least five (5) citizens who are residents of the municipality in which the project is located.
