Public notice is hereby given of the Chapter 91 License application by the City of Revere to construct and maintain access road improvements at 0 North Shore Road and 1 Gibson Way, within the Rumney Marshes ACEC within Filled Tidelands of the Pines River in the City of Revere, Essex County. The proposed project has preliminarily been determined to be a Nonwater-Dependent Infrastructure Facility.

The Department will consider all written comments on this application received by **October 9, 2026** (Public Comments Deadline). Failure of any aggrieved person or group of ten (10) citizens or more to submit written comments to the Waterways Regulation Program by the Public Comments Deadline will result in the waiver of any right to an adjudicatory hearing in accordance with 310 CMR 9.13(4)(c). The group of citizens must include at least five (5) citizens who are residents of the municipality in which the proposed project is located.
