Notice of Request for Minor Revision to Chapter 91 License No. 10233**

Applicant: City of Boston Planning and Development Agency

Project Location: Fid Kennedy Avenue and 302 Northern Ave (Parcel V-1), Raymond L. Flynn Marine Park (RLFMP), South Boston Designated Port Area (DPA), Boston, Suffolk County

Notification Date: July 8, 2026

Public Comments Deadline: August 7, 2026

Public Notice is hereby given of the Administrative Request by the City of Boston Planning and Development Agency for the realignment of a portion of Fid Kennedy Avenue between the rotary intersection with Northern Avenue and the Haul Road and through a portion of 302 Northern Ave (Parcel V-1) within the RLFMP and South Boston DPA on Filled Tidelands of Boston Harbor in (South) Boston, Suffolk County. The approval sought by the proponent at this time is limited to the reconfiguration of Fid Kennedy Avenue. The maintenance and relocation of the existing parking infrastructure facilities on Parcel V-1 does not represent a change in use from existing conditions. No change in use of Parcel V-1 has been requested at this time. The proposed project has preliminarily been determined to be accessory to a Water-Dependent Industrial Use.

Pursuant to the RLFMP Chapter 91 License No. 10233, Infrastructure Facilities as defined in 310 CMR 9.02 shall qualify as accessory to Water-Dependent Industrial (WDI) Use and Parcel V-1 is required to be dedicated exclusively to WDI Uses or accessory uses thereto. The proposed activities, as specified in Special Condition No. 5(d) of the License, states that any Infrastructure Facility on Filled Tidelands within the RLFMP may be authorized through the Minor Revision procedure set forth in Special Condition No. 6 of the License.

The Department will consider all written comments on this Application received by Friday, August 7, 2025 (Public Comments Deadline). Failure of any aggrieved person or group of ten (10) citizens or more to submit written comments to the Waterways Regulation Program by the Public Comment Deadline will result in the waiver of any right to an adjudicatory hearing in accordance with 310 CMR 9.13(4)(c). The group of citizens must include at least five (5) citizens who are residents of the municipality in which the project is located.
