Proposed Action	Non-Major Comprehensive Plan Approval
Purpose:	The Application proposes to install three new Hockmeyer mixing machines. It also proposes to reduce the current emission limits of volatile organic compounds (VOC) from 45.6 tons per consecutive 12-month period (TPY) to 32.35 TPY and of total Hazardous Air Pollutants (HAP) from 32.8 TPY to 31.71 TPY, which shall be applicable to both the existing 13 Emission Units (EU) and the proposed three EUs. In addition, ITW Performance Polymers also proposes to add a single HAP limit of 30.30 TPY.
