Proposed Action	Non-Major Comprehensive Plan Approval
Purpose:	The Application proposes to install one natural gas Tunnel Oven to expand its baking production. The proposed oven emission limits include 11.34 tons per year of volatile organic compounds from the breadmaking process, and less than 1 ton per year of nitrogen oxides, carbon monoxide, particulate matter, and sulfur dioxide, from combustion emissions.
