Pursuant to the Massachusetts Environmental Policy Act (MEPA) – 301 CMR 11, the Massachusetts Department of Fish and Game – Office of Fishing and Boating Access (OFBA) and Collins Engineers, Inc. (Collins) invite local community members, stakeholders, and interested parties to a hybrid (in-person and virtual) informational presentation and discussion regarding the proposed Plymouth Harbor Public Access Facility Improvements Project at **6:00 p.m. on May 22, 2025**. The project includes improvements to the existing boat ramp, parking lot, seawall, sidewalk, and access road at the site, and is intended to improve the coastal resilience at the site while enhancing public boating and pedestrian access.
