PROPOSED:

Safety-Kleen Systems, Inc, Marlborough (SKM) is an existing hazardous waste storage facility (Facility) operating under the terms of Hazardous Waste License #30B/15 issued by the Department of Environmental Protection (MassDEP) on September 29, 2015. SKM proposes to continue its operation and has re-applied for a five-year license. Pursuant to the public participation requirements in 310 CMR 30.800, the public has 45 days to comment on the Draft License, which has been issued by MassDEP.

PUBLIC COMMENT:

Any member of the public wishing to comment on the Draft License may file written comments during the public comment period that will extend from August 24, 2021 to October 8, 2021. Comments should be submitted to Richard Blanchet at richard.blanchet@mass.gov.

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Pursuant to 310 CMR 30.837(1), if during the comment period or within 15 days of the close of the comment period MassDEP receives written notice requesting an informal public hearing or if MassDEP determines on its own that there is significant public interest in the Draft License, MassDEP shall schedule an informal public hearing on the proposed action. Written and oral comments will be accepted at the hearing.

FINAL DECISION:

MassDEP will consider all written comments received during the comment period, along with the requirements of the Massachusetts Hazardous Waste Regulations, 310 CMR 30.000. MassDEP will then make a final decision regarding the issuance of a hazardous waste license to Safety-Kleen, Inc, Marlborough. A notice of the final license decision will be sent to the applicant and to each person who has submitted written comments or has otherwise requested notice of the final license decision. If no comments requesting a change in the Draft License are received, a final decision will become effective 21 days after the date of the notice of the decision. The final license decision will be postponed if a request for an adjudicatory hearing before the MassDEP is made within the 21 day period.
