In 1996, Purdue Pharma, under the direction of the Sackler family, launched OxyContin. Over the course of more than twenty years, Purdue waged a massive marketing campaign for their highly addictive pill. The Sackler family collected billions in profits. Since then, the opioid epidemic has claimed the lives of nearly 400,000 Americans.

Purdue Pharma declared bankruptcy in 2019. Now, many families and individuals are trying to navigate Purdue's claims process.
