## **Route 20 Preferred Concept Plan**

## **Purinton Street Intersection**

Issue	Recommendation
No pedestrian facilities along Route 20.	New sidewalk and shared-use path.
Peak hour traffic congestion.	Additional westbound travel lane on Route 20 to create a 4-lane cross section.
Current angle of intersection results in high vehicle speeds on Purinton Street and visibility issues for vehicles turning out of the side street.	Realign the last 100 feet of the roadway so that it intersects Route 20 at a right angle. This new alignment will help reduce the speed of vehicles and improve driver's ability to see vehicles coming in each direction on Route 20 as they turn out of the street.
