- 1. Call to Order and Attendance

- 2. Public Comment/Output
 - a No Public Comment.
- 3. Approval of meeting minutes (vote required)
 - a Motion to approve minutes of the 9/14/2020 meeting by Carolyn, second by Aimee. Passed 3-0.
- 4. 2020 Surveillance Report Draft Review
 - a Chris presented the commissioners with drafts for the final season reports for PVMCD member communities for feedback. Suggestions included producing more information in the 2021 outlook as well as an executive summary for PVMCD Commissioners.
- 5. 2020 Season Costs
 - a Chris presented a write up of estimated costs from the 2020 surveillance season which amounted to \$37,697 between wages, fuel, ISA, etc.
- 6. 2020 Season Pros & Cons Discussion
 - a Chris presented a write up of the pros and cons of the 2020 surveillance season to as a reference for improvement moving forward into 2021.
 - b Suggestions to improve include request testimonials from member towns and providing a survey to member towns to gauge interest for other

services. Research for water management contractors such as EZG Firm was suggested.

 - a Chris presented potential paths moving forward into 2021 as well as obstacles for offering additional services for member communities.
