- Therapy and Supervision by Electronic Means: Mr. Kelley presented the proposed Emergency Policy on Supervision and Teletherapy that would allow trainees to gain experience and supervision hours through teletherapy during the state of emergency declared by Governor Baker because of COVID-19. The Board suggested changes to the draft.
- **Temporary Licenses:** Mr. Kelley presented the proposed Emergency Policy on Temporary Licenses that would allow certain psychologists who are licensed in other states and certain Massachusetts licensees who have allowed their licenses to expire to receive temporary licenses or have their licenses reinstated on a temporary basis during the state of emergency declared by Governor Baker because of COVID-19. The Board suggested changes to the draft.

A motion was made by Dr. Jones, seconded by Dr. Glover, to approve both proposed policies with changes. The motion passed unanimously.
