## REGIONAL PLANNING and FEASIBILITY CONSULTANTS

On February 12, 2010, the State 911 Department (Department) issued a Request for Response (RFR) (State 911 10-005) for Regional Planning and Feasibility Consultants to assist public safety answering points (PSAP) with regionalization efforts. The purpose of RFR State 911 10-005 was to qualify multiple regional planning and feasibility consultants to serve as a resource to communities in their efforts to regionalize 911 services. The Department, through the RFR, established a list of consultants who were qualified under one or more of the following categories: 1) Technical Feasibility Consultant; 2) Operational Feasibility Consultant; and 3) Governance Feasibility Consultant.
