CONSENT AGREEMENT FOR REPRIMAND

The Massachusetts Board of Registration in Pharmacy (Board) and Rahel Asare (Respondent), a pharmacist licensed by the Board, License number PH39954, do hereby stipulate and agree that the following information shall be entered into and become a permanent part of the Pharmacy's record maintained by the Board:

1. The Respondent acknowledges the Board opened a Complaint against her Massachusetts pharmacist license related to the conduct set forth in Paragraph 2, identified as Docket Number PHA-2023-0111 (Complaint).
2. The Respondent and the Board agree to resolve this Complaint without making any admissions or findings and without proceeding to a formal adjudicatory hearing. The Complaint alleges the following:
 - a. The Respondent refused to fill a patient's prescription and improperly noted that the patient was under Drug Enforcement Administration (DEA) investigation.
3. The Board and Licensee acknowledge and agree that based upon the information described in Paragraph 2 the Board could find the Licensee in violation of 247 Code Mass. Regs. Section 10.03(1)(v)
4. The Respondent agrees that the Board shall impose a REPRIMAND on its license based on the facts described in Paragraph 2, effective as of the date on which the Board signs this Agreement (Effective Date).
5. The Board agrees that in return for the Respondent's execution and successful compliance with all the requirements of this Agreement, the Board will not prosecute the Complaint.
6. The Respondent understands that it has a right to formal adjudicatory hearing concerning the Complaint and that during said adjudication the Respondent would possess the right

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to confront and cross-examine witnesses, to call witnesses, to present evidence, to testify on its own behalf, to contest the allegations, to present oral argument, to appeal to the courts, and all other rights as set forth in the Massachusetts Administrative Procedures Act, Mass. Gen. Laws ch. 30A, and the Standard Adjudicatory Rules of Practice and Procedure, 801 Code Mass. Regs. § 1.01 *et seq.* The Respondent further understands that by executing this Agreement the Respondent is knowingly and voluntarily waiving its right to a formal adjudication of the Complaint.

7. The Respondent acknowledges that it has been at all times represented by Counsel or otherwise free to seek and use legal counsel in connection with the Complaint and this Agreement.
8. The Respondent acknowledges that after the Effective Date, the Agreement constitutes a public record of disciplinary action by the Board subject to the Commonwealth of Massachusetts' Public Records Law, Mass. Gen. Laws ch. 4, § 7. The Board may forward a copy of this Agreement to other licensing boards, law enforcement entities, and other individuals or entities as required or permitted by law.
9. The Respondent understands and agrees that entering into this Agreement is a voluntary and final act and not subject to reconsideration, appeal or judicial review.
10. The Respondent certified that they have read this Agreement.
