# Rail Construction Updates

Cape Main culvert replacement and Elm St, Foxboro grade crossing



The Cape Main culvert at milepost 63.22 in Sandwich was fully replaced and the far embankment was armored, protecting against future storm surges.



A completed grade crossing upgrade at Elm St. in Foxboro is a part of a series of safety upgrades being constructed along the Framingham Secondary rail line.
