MassDOT Board Meeting September 16, 2019

Transit: RTAs and New Workforce Grants



- All 15 Regional Transit Authorities (RTAs) have signed MOUs and will now receive the formulaic portion of their FY20 State Contract Assistance
 - \$87m compared to \$82m in FY19
 - Will be supplemented by \$3.5m in discretionary grants.
 - MOUs contain metrics for improvement in areas of ridership, customer service & satisfaction, asset management, and financial performance, including farebox recovery ratio.
 - > 12 of the 15 MOUs also contain "stretch goals" such as:
 - Develop on-time performance metric other than the "out of the barn" measurement
 - Increase travel training to attract new riders and decrease reliance on demand response
 - Increase social media outreach
 - GHG reduction
- Second meeting of revived RTA Council scheduled for September 17th in Yarmouth
 - > FTA Public Transportation Agency Safety Plans (PTASPs) to be primary topic
- Workforce Transportation program application period now open.
 - Will award up to \$4.5m to support new travel options for workforce
 - CMAQ and TNC funds
 - 3 training sessions attracted more than 50 attendees
 - Application period scheduled to close September 27, 2019

Rail: Valley Flyer

Massachusetts Department of Transportation
Rail & Transit Division

- 2 year pilot giving Greenfield, Northampton and Holyoke more frequent service to CT, NYC and beyond
- Serves same stations in Massachusetts as the Vermonter (operating between VT and Washington, DC)
- Triples weekday service to Greenfield, Northampton, and Holyoke
- Goal is to nearly double ridership at Greenfield, Northampton, and Holyoke on existing Vermonter service
- Introductory discount to be followed by locally led marketing program
- First day of service August 30
