ACADEMY STAFF INSTRUCTOR OPPORTUNITY

The Municipal Police Training Committee is bolstering their Staff Instructor cadre at the MPTC Randolph Police Academy. If you are interested in becoming a Staff Instructor for the MPTC at the Randolph Academy, please review the following requirements, prior to submitting your resume:

- At least 5 years' experience as a police officer
- If you are not retired, your Chief must provide written endorsement to the MPTC Basic Training Division Manager Kelsey Whelihan and Randolph Police Academy Director Kaitlyn Mori that you are in good standing with the department, and they approve you to work as a Staff Instructor.
- Participate in the interview process with the MPTC Basic Training Manager Kelsey Whelihan and Randolph Academy Director Kaitlyn Mori.
- If you are not already certified as a Staff Instructor, you must attend the **Staff Instructor Certification Course (3-day) at MPTC Marlborough on July 14 - 16 from 0800-1600 hours.**
- If you are not already certified as a PT Instructor, you must attend the **PT Instructor Certification Course (1-day) at MPTC Marlborough on July 17 from 0800-1600 hours.**
- All Staff Instructors must maintain active **POST Certification.**
- All MPTC Instructors must be in compliance with the **MPTC Code of Conduct.**
- If retired, it is strongly encouraged to have an active License to Carry and/or LEOSA.

The next ROC at the Randolph Police Academy is scheduled to start August 3, 2026.
