DECISION

LINH LIQUORS, INC. DBA NORTH RANDOLPH PLAZA LIQUORS 1165 NORTH MAIN STREET RANDOLPH, MA 02368 LICENSE # 100800050 HEARD 12/27/2011

Linh Liquors, Inc. dba North Randolph Plaza Liquors (the "Licensee") holds an all alcohol license issued pursuant to M.G.L. c. 138, §15. The Alcoholic Beverages Control Commission (the "Commission") held a hearing on Tuesday, December 27, 2011, regarding an alleged violation of M.G.L. c. 138 §34. Prior to the commencement of the hearing, the licensee stipulated to the violation alleged in Investigator John Carey's Compliance Check Field Report.

The following documents are in evidence:

- 2. Compliance Check Field Report of John Carey dated August 3, 2011.
- A. Color Photograph of Licensee's New I.D. Scanner;

- D. Color Photograph of Lottery Digital Scanner Showing Age 21 Birthdate.

FACTS

- 1. On Thursday August 3, 2011, at approximately 5:20 p. m., Investigators Carey and Teehan investigated the business operation of Linh Liquors, Inc. dba North Randolph Plaza Liquors.
- 2. An underage operative, working with the investigators, purchased a six-pack of Bud Light for seven dollars and fifty cent (\$7.50). The underage operative was not asked for identification.
- 3. The underage operative was nineteen (19) years old, with a date of birth of May 24, 1992.
- 4. An administrative review of the files indicates the licensee has held the license for eleven (11) years and has no prior violations.

CONCLUSION

Based on the evidence, the Commission finds the licensee violated M.G.L. c.138, §34. As the licensee has been in business for more than ten (10) years and has no previous violations, the Commission issues a **WARNING**.
