**DECISION**

**GREYHOUND PACKAGE STORE INC.  
676 BROADWAY  
RAYNHAM, MA 02767

Greyhound Package Store Inc. (the "Licensee") holds an alcohol license issued pursuant to M.G.L. c. 138, § 15. The Alcoholic Beverages Control Commission (the "Commission") held a hearing on Tuesday, July 18, 2017, regarding an alleged violation of 204 CMR 2.05 (2) – Permitting an illegality on the licensed premises, to wit: M.G.L. c. 138, §34 – Sale or delivery of an alcoholic beverage to a person under twenty-one (21) years of age. Prior to the commencement of the hearing, the Licensee stipulated to the violation alleged in Investigator Lordan's Report.

The following documents are in evidence:

1. Licensee's Stipulation of Facts; and
2. Investigator Lordan's Compliance Check Field Report; and
3. Letter from Raynham Police Detective Louis Pacheco.

There is one (1) audio recording of this hearing.

The Commission took Administrative Notice of the Licensee's record.

**FACTS**

1. On Wednesday, April 19, 2017, at approximately 6:09 p.m., Investigators Temple and Lordan ("Investigators") investigated the business operation of Greyhound Package Store Inc.
2. An underage operative, working with Investigators, purchased from the Licensee an alcoholic beverage, a 6-pack of Bud Light beer, for eight dollars and thirty cents (\$8.30). The underage operative was not asked for identification.

## CONCLUSION


Based on the evidence the Commission finds the Licensee violated 204 CMR 2.05 (2) - Permitting an illegality on the licensed premises, to wit: M.G.L. c. 138, §34 – Sale or delivery of an alcoholic beverage to a person under twenty-one (21) years of age. Therefore, the Commission **suspends the license for three (3) days of which three (3) days will be held in abeyance for a period of two (2) years provided no further violations of Chapter 138 or Commission Regulations occur.**
