Southern Segment:


North of King Phillip Street to South of I-495 ramps, with an exclusion at Center Street

Northern Segment:

North of I-495 ramps to North of Robinson Street

Total Project Length 2.86 Miles

- Enhance Safety at Britton, Richard, Carver and Elm Street Intersections
- Provide ADA Compliant Pedestrian Accommodations
- Provide Bicycle Accommodations

Traffic and Safety Needs



Frequent Crashes

- Over 150 crashes along Broadway (Rte 138) Corridor during a 4-year period
- Intersection of Broadway (Rte138) at Carver Street is ranked #101 on MassDOT's Top 200 Crash Cluster list for the period 2015-2017
- Intersection of Broadway (Rte138) at Elm Street was classified as a Highway Safety Improvement Program (HSIP) cluster for the period from 2012-2014.
- Majority of crashes along the corridor occurred at the 2 intersections above and were primarily angle-type crashes.

Construction Scope



Improvements with Resurfacing and Related Work on Route 138:

- Remove existing concrete subbase and Replace with Full Depth Pavement
- Provide ADA Compliant Pedestrian Accommodations
- Provide Sidewalks and Bicycle Accommodations on both sides of corridor
- Replace and Improve Drainage System
- Improve treatment of runoff with Stormwater BMP
- Relocate existing sanitary sewer and water utilities
- Install new non-participating watermain for the North Raynham Water District
- Culvert Improvements and Extensions




Improvements with Resurfacing and Related Work on Route 138:

- Upgrade existing traffic signals/controls at existing signalized intersections
- Install emergency vehicle preemption at signalized intersections
- Provide pedestrian and bicycle accommodations at the existing signalized intersections
- Install RRFB at midblock crossing between Britton Street and Center Street
- Provide exclusive left-turn lanes at signalized intersections
- Update signage throughout the corridor




Proposed Improvements: Carver Street

Procurement



- Project was advertised July 31, 2021
- Engineers Estimate was \$16,106,757.50
- Bid Opening was September 8, 2021
- Six (6) bids were received:

•	Baltazar Contractors Inc.	\$17,900,377.00
•	AR Belli Inc.	\$18,439,916.00
•	P Gioioso & Sons Inc.	\$18,866,140.00

- \$13,536,267.50 cost for this construction contract is funded with 80% Federal Highway Funds and 20% State funds.
- \$2,395,699.00 cost for this construction contract is funded with 90% Federal Highway Funds and 10% State funds.
- \$47,430.00 cost is funded with 100% State Funds
- \$127,361.00 cost is funded by the Town of Raynham

Programmed Cost in 2021 TIP: \$22,373,775.00
