#### **OPTION A: RELEASED VALUE \$ .60 per pound per article.**

- No charge for this option, it is required by law and is automatically included.
- This is free coverage based on \$.60 per pound per article on transit related claims.
- Storage claims are covered at \$.30/lb. per article. Not to exceed \$2,000 per lot.
- The protection of your goods is based on their weight not the actual value.

EXAMPLE: If your \$1000, 75-pound flat screen TV breaks, the moving company would compensate you .60x75lbs totalling \$45.

#### **OPTION B: ACTUAL CASH VALUE**

- Actual cash value is a declared lump sum value based on a minimum of \$1.25 per lb.
- The shipper is responsible for placing a value on the shipment of goods.
- Under this level of valuation, depreciation will apply to any claim made.
- Under this level of valuation, the Carrier is not obligated to write out a check for the entire declared shipment value.
- Each damaged item will be repaired, replaced, or a cash settlement may be offered, according to its depreciated value, not to exceed the the shipment's declared value.

EXAMPLE: If a shipment weighs 10,000#'s the min required declared value for is \$12,500. If there is a total loss in transit the maximum liability to the carrier is \$12,500 at a cost of \$81.25 to the customer.

#### **OPTION C: FULL REPLACEMENT VALUATION (FVR)**

- FVR is based on a minimum declared value of \$4.00 per pound.
- Shipper is responsible for placing a value on the shipment of goods.
- The carrier will NOT apply depreciation under this option.
- If any article is lost, destroyed or damage while in the Carriers' custody, the carrier, at it's discretion will, offer to repair the item, replace with a similar item, or make a cash settlement for the cost of the repair, or the current market replacment value.

EXAMPLE: If a shipment weighs 10,000#'s the min required declared value for is \$40,000. If there is a total loss in transit the maximum liability to the carrier is \$40,000 at a cost of \$380 to the customer.

Shipper is responsible for placing a value on the shipment of goods tendered to Carrier under Options B or C. By undervaluing the declared value, recovery could be limited. In addition, shipper has 15 days after the delivery date to file a claim.

For example, if the shipper selects Option "C" on Bill of Lading and declares a total value of \$10,000 on a 15,000 pound shipment and a 1,500 pound piano (worth \$20,000 when tendered to Carrier) is lost or destroyed, SHIPPER SHOULD NOT EXPECT THE CARRIER TO TENDER \$10,000 DURING ADJUSTMENT OF A TIMELY FILED PROPERLY WRITTEN NOTICE OF CLAIM. This is because prior to tendering the goods to Carrier, the declared value on the entire shipment was \$10,000 which, as it turns out, is less than the replacement value of the piano. In this example, Carrier's liability would be limited to 10% of the value you declared on the shipment under FVR. The most recent "ATA" (formerly AMSA) Table of Weights will be used in calculating liability on all claims.

In the event of loss, where weight of shipment is not known, a constructive weight of 7 pounds per cubic foot of properly loaded van space or container shall be deemed to apply as the unit of measurement for purposes of ascertaining Carrier's Liability.
