Executive Director Report

Kristin Mitchell informed the Board of the following information:

Since the Board's last meeting (2/21/24), the Board has received 773 applications for exam.

Since the Board's last meeting, the Board has issued 340 licenses:

- 257 Salesperson by exam
- 28 Broker by exam
- 11 Attorney Brokers
- 18 Businesses
- 8 Reciprocal Brokers
- 18 Reciprocal Salespersons
 - 2 Instructors

Ms. Mitchell also informed the board that PSI is processing applications within the one month window.

Board Counsel Report

Jenna Hentoff wanted to notify the Board that a settlement has been reached regarding litigation involving the National Association of Realtors though it is subject to court approval. After a brief discussion, the Board noted that this settlement does not impact the Board's work as it does not affect Massachusetts licensing law or regulations.

Application Review

Peter Wokoun– He submitted an application to reinstate his salesperson license. His salesperson license was issued in 1988 and it expired in 2008. In his application, he disclosed that he had discipline against securities licenses that he held in the 1990's. He paid a fine, received a censure, and was barred from working with that organization any longer. This happened over twenty years ago, and he has not worked in the financial world since then. He currently resides in Texas. He holds a Real Estate license there and it is in good standing.
